## About the program

Screen NSW, in partnership with Australians in Film (AiF), offers NSW screen practitioners the opportunity to secure access to two dedicated co-working spaces at [Charlie's in Los Angeles](#). The two free creative workspaces are available for NSW based screen practitioners visiting LA to conduct business, collaborate, and network.

Successful applicants to Charlie's will receive access to:

- Up to two desks and a writers' room with whiteboards and screens
- Wi-Fi
- An equipped kitchen
- AiF staff.

Charlie's is located in the Writer's Building at [The Lot Studios](#) in West Hollywood.

# Eligibility

## Who can apply

NSW-based screen practitioners who are visiting LA for the purpose of professional development or screen industry related business can apply to access up to two Screen NSW hot desks, free of charge.

Please note:

- NSW-based means the applicant must be based in and working from NSW, and ordinarily have lived in NSW for at least six months immediately prior to the date of the application
- Applicants must be over 18 years.

Screen NSW is keen to support applicants whose use of *Charlie's* will have a direct benefit to their career, projects and ultimately the NSW screen industry.

## Assessment process

Applications will be reviewed by the Program Manager and Head of Screen NSW.

Applicants will be notified within two weeks regarding the outcome of their application.

If successful, the applicant must enter into and abide by the terms of an agreement with Screen NSW, which will include deliverables and acquittal requirements.

# FAQ and Resources

## Is there funding available to support my trip?

No. All costs associated with travel to LA are to be met by the applicant.

Access to Charlie's is a service initiative not a grant.

## I am travelling with the creative team. How many desks can we apply for?

Those working in a team can apply for up to two people to access the desks via the one application.

## Will I need travel Insurance?

Yes. All applicants granted access to *Charlie's* via Screen NSW, will be required to provide proof of travel insurance which includes but is not limited to covering health and medical situations and the applicant's personal items, possessions, and equipment.

## Do I need a visa?

Yes. It will be the responsibility of all successful applicants to ensure they have the correct visas for any activity they will be engaging in whilst in the USA.

## Is access transferable?

No. Access to *Charlie's* will be granted to only the successful applicant for the specified time. Access cannot be transferred or passed onto anyone else.

## Will I need to sign a contract?

Yes. Successful applicants will enter into an Agreement with Screen NSW about their access to *Charlie's* and the requirements and obligations of that access including abiding by a Code of Conduct.
